Pawar Public School Nanded City, Pune Minutes of the EPTA Meeting held on Thursday, 29th August, 2024, at 8:00 am in Conference Hall.

Principal Ma'am chaired the meeting.

Agenda:

- 1) Final presentation of the revised school fees.
- 2) Miscellaneous points from EPTA members and school briefing of activities.

The revised school fees were presented in tabular form, with the fees for 2024-25 shown for comparison with the revised fees. The discussion from one EPTA member was whether 10% hike can be considered. Principal ma'am said that school is lagging far behind in fees collection for 4-5 years due to many parents still not paying fees, even this year.

There is only 2% difference in the fee amount if the fees rise is by 12% instead of 10%.

- A reminder was given that few parents have yet not paid the previous years fees.
- Ma'am added that:

The school gives priority to quality education and takes up numerous activities that fulfill the learning objectives and attain the learning outcomes.

The school doesnot let the academics of the students hamper if any teacher is going on leave. We make it a point to recruit new teachers well in advance.

Unanimously the E-PTA members agreed to the new fee rise that was put forth by the school (not even 15% as per the Govt. rules.

- For current students, a fee hike of 12% for the next two academic years i:e 2025-2026 and 2026-2027 from Jr. Kg to Grade X was finalized.
- For the new Nursery Class 15% hike in fees was finalized.
- Admission Fee finalized is Rs. 10,000/- and Refundable Caution Money Deposit for new admissions is Rs. 65,000/-. This will not be applicable to old students.
- A break up of the changed fees amount was shown and explained when required.
- ➤ This change is accounted for in expenses in Maintenance of school, additional infrastructure for new divisions in secondary school, upgrading smart boards in older classes, qualitative improvement in students opportunities like introducing skill based subjects as per CBSE and NEP 2020, staff salary, PF, Mediclaim Gratuity etc.

Principal ma'am briefed about the various activities taken in school like introduction of STEM course (Science technology, Engineering, Math based) AI, Design Thinking, Financial literacy and how it is the need of the hour.

- ➤ Koun Banenga Sports Star will be held in school on account of National Sport's Day.
- > Our students participated in the MUN (Model United nations) conference at PPS Amanora and competed with several good schools. This gave them a good exposure and students gauged their own competency level outside school.

Parents concerns:

- ➤ Equal opportunities to be given to all children. In some classes, only few children are called out for events.
- Ma'am replied that the school will take care of this. Ma'am informed the parents that 'Fashion Show' event is planned for Grade II and III where all the students will get an opportunity to be there on stage.
- > Parents find it difficult during examination as the notebooks are incomplete and no remark from the teacher.
- Ma'am answered: Some children are habitual defaulters. The teachers are taking efforts on the same line. Remedial classes are conducted. But the issue of picking up the students after school as well as Saturday commuting problem creates a hindrance for the school's approach for remedial classes. Parents too have to be active and develop the habit of regular studies among children at the primary stage.
- Few of the books were given late and the parents had to provide the receipt which was difficult for them. They requested to not take money for the books not available and can be sent later as per the availability.
- Ma'am answered: It would be chaotic for the teachers as well as the admin for the process of collecting amount for 1-2 books. The teacher would have to utilize her teaching period for the same, which would be a loss for the class. The admin would be overcrowded for the same and not feasible.
- Next year the book sale will be kept for more days instead of 8 days. And though
 dates are allocated to the parents, they tend to come late and it gets crowded on
 certain days.

The meeting concluded on a happy note and vote of thanks was conveyed by the Teacher Secretary.
