1. Welcome note and greeting by chair person.

4. **Exam Policy Term.**

A complaint box is installed at the ground floor where students can register their complaints, these complains will be addressed on priority. Ma'am continued saying that Escort ID is compulsory or else the child will not be handed to the guardian concerned. Mrs Jigna Patel appreciated the decision made by the school regarding students' pickup policy. Mrs Marathe said that the school bus should have female attendant compulsorily for students on boards and police verification for the staff. The Principal convinced that as per the government GR , POCSO committee has been constituted for students safety. The school will abide by all the rules for safety of our students.

Resolution: It was hereby resolved that the school will abide by the safety clause laid by government and indicators as on CBSE portal.
