- School Cafeteria food was served to the members.
- Ms. Grade 3 parents representative provided the feedback about increasing academic conceptual understanding and keeping a check on the multitude of events conducted.
 - o Increase in opportunities to participate in inter school events and competition.
 - o A concern on the movie shown during the Movie week for Grade 3 and 4 was raised.

Resolution: Ms. Aditi Mukherjee addressed the concerns and resolved it. Extension of providing support sessions for the specific cases for conceptual clarity was informed.

- Ms. Obu Lakshmi Grade 4 representative informed the management about the difficulty in curriculum, its delivery and the pace of the portion/ syllabus covered.
 - o A concern regarding the absence of the chess coach
 - Students do not complete the Home Extensions.
 - Providing opportunities to more children for participation in the races for Annual Sports Day.
 - o Discipline issues in Grade 4 were discussed.
- Mr. Dungarwal discussed a few concerns related to Grade 5 and 7.
 - o Grade 5 Math -Students are finding it difficult to understand the concepts.
 - o Grade 7 Math Teacher change .Students are happy with the new teacher.
 - o Marathi and French need more classes as students need more basic learning.
 - Chess teacher absence raised.
 - o The football field gets very hot during the afternoons.
 - Installation of Microsoft applications (latest versions) on the smart screens in the classrooms
 - Use of foul or abusive language in the class may be looked into.
- Ms. Surbhi Mishra Grade 9 representative appreciated the efforts and contribution of the teachers, staff, Principal and management.
 - Teacher attrition and retention is a concern as mentioned by the parent.
 - Lack of emotional support, psychological counseling and social issues.
 - o Clarity on Number of worksheets sent.
- Resolution: Ms. Aditi Mukherjee addressed the concerns and resolved it.

Syllabus will be reviewed and chalked out before every Milestone depending on the time frame. We are in constant communication with the curriculum team about the same.

Extra classes will be arranged for students who need extra help on working saturdays.

Sports-Heats are conducted before the finals on the sports day. It is not possible to have all 800 students competing on the same day. Drills and March past will have 100 % participation.

Discipline Issues-The school is looking into this and is working towards the same.

Home extension Correction- The teacher corrects the class work and the learner book. Home extension is generally not corrected as it is optional. Ms. Mukherjee informed the parents that if
