Report on Damini Marshal Arts: Ms. Prachi Golwilkar informed all EPTA members that On August 22nd, 2024, Police Sub Inspector and Damini Marshals from Swargate Police Station conducted an awareness seminar on self-defense, preparing students of Grade 5 to 10 to effectively handle unexpected situations and ensure their safety. They covered key topics such as distinguishing between good touch and bad touch and reducing excessive mobile usage. Students were advised to avoid quarrels and use of abusive language in school. They also emphasized the need to be vigilant against photo morphing and warned against accepting rides from unknown individuals. They provided essential helpline numbers, including Child Helpline Number 1098 and Women Helpline Number 112.
