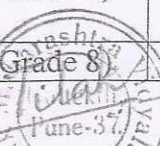

1.	Confirm the minutes of the Second General Body Meeting held on 24 th August 2024.	Principal Madam greeted and welcomed the parents for the fourth EPTA Meeting 2024-25. She ascertained the quorum and declared that the meeting was in order. Minutes of the previous meeting held on 24 th August 2024 were read by principal madam.
2.	Picnic And educational Trip	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A one day picnic for pre primary to grade 5th has been planned in the first week of February 25'. Details of the same will be shared with the parents. For std 6th, 7th and 8th an educational trip to ISRO and statue of Unity, Gujarat has been planned after 15th March 2025 and quotation for the same has been received by the school. The tentative amount for the same is Rs.20, 000/- excluding airfares. A detailed program for the same will be shared with the parents once finalized and consent form will also be shared.
3.	Admission Process for the next Admission Process for the year 2025-2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Admission has already begun for the academic year 2025-26. Grade 2 will have only one division with 40 as maximum number. New session will commence from 1st April 2025. Portion for new session will begin from 1st April 2025 itself. Madam also mentioned that for Grade 9th extra classes will be conducted after Annual exam. The time table for new session has total of 45 periods with 9 periods each from Monday to Friday. Madam also shared subject allocation for grade 9th Maths(Code: 041) , Science (Code:086), SST(Code:087), English(code 184) as Compulsory subjects Hindi (Code:002)/ Sanskrit(Code:122) (option to choose one) for L2. Marathi (Code 009) (Compulsory) - graded subject. Skill subjects- IT (Code:402) and Introduction to Financial Market(Code: 405) (graded Subjects along with Art and PE) Grade 6-8th -Marathi compulsory subject Hindi/ Sanskrit – (select any one)
4.	Note book and text book details for 2025-26.	<p>Principal madam mentioned that school is committed to providing the students with the tools they need to achieve academic success. Textbooks are carefully selected which ensures holistic development of the children.</p> <p>For academic year 2025-26</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For Preprimary – Grade 5- Viva publication books will be used. For grades 6 -9th -NCERT books shall be used along with other reference books. Five fingers for Marathi and Sanskrit. The curriculum would be enriched with various activities in each subject.
