Minutes of the Meeting:

- · Director Ms. Namrata Majhail welcomed all the members present.
- . Before commencing the proceedings, the quorum was confirmed to ensure the required number of participants were present.

 The agenda for the meeting was shared with all members-

- Budget Overview of AY 2024-25 Expenditure Projections for AY 2025-26
- Fee Proposal for AY 2025-26

Overview of the Budget AY 2023-24 and Fee Ratification Proposal for AY 2024-25

- . Members were apprised of the Fee Fixation Act and the process to be followed for the
- . The past six years fee hikes were shared to get a historical perspective.
- Proposed Income (receivables minus RTE) of Academic Year 2024-25 was shared with the parents.
- . The proposed expenditure based on actuals till September 2024 and projected for October 2024 to March 2025 for AY 2024-25 was presented to the members.
- Parents were apprised of the concept of permissible allowance and how it is calculated and the summary of total expenditure and total income.
- Income based on fees for full capacity including RTE, fees receivable minus RTE and government contribution towards RTE too were shared.
- The proposed expenditure of 2025-26 based on expenditure of 2024-25 was also
- presented to the members. The context of the deficit was explained to the members.

 Parent Representative suggested that the school should relook at the fee hise as 8—10% would not be able to cover the expenses and this would directly impact the
- teacher's salary thus affecting the quality of teaching learning.

 It was suggested that the school should build a corpus fund so that it can help the school tide over any deficit that gets created.
- The rationale for the additional cost was also shared with the parents.

 Ms. Namrata Majhail announced the upcoming plans of the school involved Opening of Balvatika section, major infra related work to accommodate the new realities and MacBook procurement was shared with the parents.

 The school shared the RTE component and its impact from 2014-15.

 Parents suggested that the school should explore the CSR possibilities with the
- corporates. Parents mentioned that they will form a group and explore this area and help the school.
- · Parent Representatives also suggested to the school that the one-time admission fee be increased to Rs 1,00,000 per student instead of Rs 75,000.
- There was another perspective shared by the parent member that one-time admission fee should not be increased as the brand value of school will be impacted.
- · Parent Representative suggested if the school can relook at the sports facilities given to the Primary.

- Principal Sangeeta Kapoor gave them clarification on the Primary school sports program and mentioned that the school will make it visible what happens in the sports program.
- Based on the proposed expenditure for 2025-26, two proposals of fee hike were tabled. Many deliberations happened on the proposals.
- Proposal 1 10 % hike; Proposal 2- 12 % hike.
- The PTA members agreed on the rationale for proposing the fee hike of AY 2025-26.
 The PTA members were given time to discuss and arrive with the decision amongst the two proposals of 10% and 12%.
- PTA members were then individually asked to state their choice as the fee hike for AY
- . The majority of the PTA members agreed on the fee hike of 12% for AY 2025-26 for
- classes I to XI. It was also announced that for classes XI and XII, as the same fee structure is applicable for 2 years for the students, there would be no hike in fees for the students in Class
- XII for Academic Year 2025-26.
- The important dates for Class I and XI admissions were also shared with the members.
- . Ms. Namrata Majhail thanked all the parents for attending the meeting.
