




Key Discussions:

Possible Resolution Examples:

1. Fee Hike Approval: "The EPTA and school administration agree to approve the 8% fee hike for the current academic year and 7% for the next academic year.
2. Transparency and Utilization: "The school administration agrees to provide detailed breakdowns of fee utilization to EPTA, ensuring transparency in financial management."
3. Support Measures: "The school will implement support measures, such as scholarships or financial aid, to assist students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, impacted by the fee hike."
4. Review and Monitoring: "The EPTA and school administration will conduct regular reviews to assess the impact of fee hikes and ensure that the increased revenue is utilized effectively for school development."

Decisions/Actions:

- The fee hike for the current academic year was approved with an 8% increase.
- The fee hike for the next academic year was discussed and approved with a 7% increase.

A resolution include:

- Approving the proposed fee hikes
- Addressing school concerns (e.g., infrastructure, resources)
- Outlining actions to mitigate the impact of fee hikes on students/families

Key Components:

1. Clear statement of the decision
2. Specific actions or measures agreed upon
3. Responsibilities and accountability
4. Timeline for implementation

The resolution should reflect the agreements and decisions made during the meeting, providing a clear direction for future actions.
