- Over the last 2 years the overall fitness of the entire students has improved.
- 2 years ago in the Academic Year 22-23, about 70% of the students were able to achieve this.



Now in the Academic year 24-25, 80% of the students can achieve this standard.

Also, our fitness is higher when compared to students from other schools. We have a method
of assessing this. Only 50% of the students who take admission with us directly in Class 5 are
able to achieve a score of 16.

Cricket net


One thing our children are longing to have in our school is the cricket net. Their wish is granted and the cricket net will soon witness our champions practicing playing cricket.
