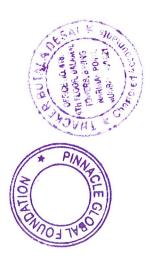

- B Fixed Assets are accounted at cost plus incidental charges related therewith to bring the asset put to use
- C Depreciation has been provided on W.D.V. method as per the prevailing rates and manner prescribed under Income Tax Act 1961.
- D Admission fees up to the FY 2022-23 were accounted in the year for which the admission was given. With effect from FY 2023-24 fee income has been treated as income in the year in which it is received.
- E Stock is valued at cost or net realisable value whichever is lower.
- F Gratuity accounted on actual basis.
- G The Trust has received a Term loan Of Rs.20,00,00,000 in 2020-21 from Standerd Charted Bank Secured by Hypothecation of movable properties and by creation of charges on Immovable properties.
