Agenda/Points	Discussion/Decision
Welcoming and Introduction	Ms. Ana Dominguez welcomed the Transport Committee members and provided an overview of the school's transport services. She explained the various safety measures in place to ensure the well-being of students during transit, emphasizing the school's commitment to maintaining a secure and efficient transportation system.
Safety measures	Mr. Shubham Dagade provided a briefing on the safety measures implemented for student transportation. He highlighted key initiatives such as the presence of a compulsory female attendant on each bus, installation of GPS trackers and CCTV cameras in all school buses, and mandatory police verification for all transport staff. These measures ensure a safe and secure environment for students during transit.
Health check ups	Mr. Dhonde suggested conducting regular health check-ups for drivers and female attendants, focusing on both physical and mental health. He emphasized that mental well-being is just as important as physical health, especially since these staff members interact closely with students and parents on a daily basis.
Surprise check on driver	Mr. Shirodkar suggested conducting random surprise checks on drivers using a breathalyzer. He emphasized that such checks would encourage drivers to remain more cautious and responsible, thereby enhancing overall safety for students.
Traffic inside the Puranik society	The committee discussed the issue of traffic congestion in the mornings, particularly caused by vehicles parked on the road near Puranic Society. Mr. Shirodkar suggested addressing this

	concern by submitting a letter to the Traffic Department. He proposed implementing an odd-even day parking system in the area to help reduce traffic jams during school hours.
Traffic warden during arrival and dispersal time	Mr. Kukate suggested submitting a request to the Traffic Department to appoint a traffic warden near the Police Station during school pick-up and drop-off hours. This measure would help manage traffic more effectively and ensure the safety of students during these peak times.
Parent satisfaction	Ms. Preeti expressed that, as a parent, she is fully satisfied with the safety measures the school takes to ensure the safety of its students.
