Second PTA Executive Meeting 24.11.2025

Academic Year 2025–2026

Minutes of the meeting:

1. School Timings:

- PTA members suggested that the last reporting time to school should be 8:45 a.m.
- Notices should be given to regular latecomers.
- PTA members requested that school buses arrive earlier to ensure that students are not late to school.

2. School Uniform:

- PTA members agreed that students must report to the school in full school uniform, including the uniform sweater.

3. PDF Policy (Grades 1, 2 & 3):

- PTA members agreed that no need to share PDF in the class group to encourage better academic habits.
- Students who are absent for genuine reasons may contact their class teachers personally for classwork and homework PDF.

4. Pending Fees:

- PTA members suggested that students with last year's pending fees should receive an official notice.
- They also suggested taking a written application from such parents and guiding them to clear the dues.

5. Proposed Fee Hike (2026–2027):

- **PTA members agreed 15% increase in the tuition fee for the next academic year.**
- Management members and Principal Maam agreed that the institution will soon shift to a new building with improved facilities such as Spacious classrooms, science labs, computer labs, library, indoor games, and well qualified and experienced staff.
- **The school has not revised the fee structure for the past 4 years, and there will be no increase for the next 3 years as well.**

6. Parents' Behaviour Issues:

- It was agreed that if any students' parents misbehave with principal or staff, the school will file a police complaint against them.
- Similarly, if any student misbehaves with Principal or staff then that student will be suspended for a few days to set an example.

7. Common Suggestions from PTA members:

- Appreciate students with stars or small gifts to motivate them.
- Request not to increase transport fees.
- School's protocols, rules, and regulations should be signed by all parents and displayed on the notice board.
- Instead of only a science exhibition, parents suggested organizing Parents Carnival/Fun Fair along with art, craft, and painting exhibitions.
- **PTA members suggested that all students should bring stainless-steel water bottle and tiffin box for better health and hygiene.**
- **Note: The edges should not be sharp.**
- Introduce more games such as Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Skipping, Hop-on-one-foot (Langadi), Tennikot, etc.

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
