authorised Bank.
- 2) The management should appoint trained Graduate teachers in
the school.
- 3) The management should provide adequate and sufficient accomoda
tion to the school and adequate and sufficient furniture,
science equipment and other contingency.
- 4) The management would not be paid any Grant-in-aid any time in
future and if they find that they are unable to run the school
on no-grant-in-aid basis they will have to do close down the
school. The necessary undertaking to this effect signed by the
President and the office barers of the management should be
sent to this office within a period of 8 days from the date of
receipt of this letter.
- 5) The other conditions mentioned Rule 3 of the S.S.Code regarding
conditions of the recognisions will have to be fulfilled by
the management.

para 4 above further orders of regular permission will be issued
by this office.

Please refer to your D.O. letter No. SSM/3874/2003/(II) B dated 10.2.75 regarding opening of new secondary schools permanently on no grant-in-aid basis at Kirkee and at Chinchwad.

St. Ursula School at Chinchwad was recognised as a secondary school with English Medium during 1974.75 for VIII and IXth stds and the All Saints school Kirkee was recognised during 74-75 for std. VIII th only.

The recognition to both these schools was granted during 74-75 only under Government letter No. SSM/3874/2003 (II) B dt. 6-11-74. The Managements have approached me for granting permission to open std. Xth and std. IX respectively as a normal expansion of the school. I am, therefore, to request you to move Government to issue the necessary orders in the matter to enable the schools concerned to admit the students. The school in respective classes during 75-76 and to enable the Education Officer, Zilla Parishad, Poona to issue the necessary orders sanctioning stds IX and Xth to the above mentioned schools.
